Terms and Conditions

General rules and conditions

1. This promotion is in no way sponsored, endorsed, administered by, or associated with Facebook.
2. In order to be included, an entry is deemed as an emailed photograph (deemed appropriate by a Media Subcommittee member).
3. Emailed photographs are to be received before each weekly cut off date.
4. Only residents of Woodcroft and Morphet Vale South Australia are eligible to submit images.
5. Staff and relatives are ineligible for the prize, although are invited to participate. Relatives will be defined for this purpose as husband, wife, de facto, father, mother, son, daughter. Volunteers are welcome to participate and are eligible for prizes.
6. More than one person in a household can participate.
7. People can participate each week.
8. Entries limited at 3 per person.
9. There is no minimum age to participate in the competition; however, permission must be received from an appropriate adult.
10. Weekly prizes valued at \$50. The competition is for 12 weeks. Total prizes \$600.
11. The prizes are not redeemable for cash or transferable.
12. Winners will be notified by email within 3 business days of result.
13. The prize can be picked up by the winner within 8 weeks of notification.
14. The Woodcroft Morphet Vale Neighbourhood Centre shall not be held liable for any damage whatsoever which is suffered (including but not limited to indirect or consequential loss) for any personal injury suffered or sustained as a result of or as a connection with entering the competition or the prize except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law.
15. The Woodcroft Morphet Vale Neighbourhood Centre takes no responsibility for any late or misdirected entries.
16. Information provided by you will be collected and managed by the Woodcroft Morphet Vale Neighbourhood Centre in accordance with the Privacy and Personal Information Protection (PPIP) Act 1998, under which you have the rights of access and correction.

18. Entries will be voted on by the public, through Facebook 'likes' on individual images.
19. Votes will be counted at 1pm exactly on the closing day.

21. The winning images will be prominently displayed on the Centre's website and images will be enlarged onto faux canvas to form an exhibition in the Centre, remaining the property of the Centre.
